The History Behind the Lake Shore Sail Club Team Race

The "Race"

The Inter-Club Team Championship Race is an invitational race held each fall on Lake St. Clair. DRYA member clubs are invited to send a four boat team to compete for the "Best of the Best" bragging rights.

In 1982, Commodore Mike McGuire initiated the concept of sponsoring a TEAM RACE. This annual event, officially known as the "Inter-Club Team Championship Race" has continued to bring out the "Best of the Best" racers from each club.

During the twenty-eight years the race has been held, eighteen clubs have competed. The longest consecutive tenure any club has held the cup is four years.

Flags are awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place clubs at Race Headquarters following the race. The *Inter-Club Team Race Championship Trophy* will be presented to the winning club's Commodore at Lake Shore Sail Club Commodore's Ball in February 2011.

Dear DRYA Member Club,

Lake Shore Sail Club is, once again, proud to sponsor the 29th Annual Inter-Club Team Championship Race ("Team Race"). The Officers, Board of Directors, and Members of LSSC wish to extend an invitation (challenge?) to your Club to compete with us in this race. We would very much appreciate your participation and would consider it an honor for your team to compete in this year's race to determine the "Best of the Best".

This race is open by invitation to all organizations holding current membership in the Detroit Regional Yacht-Racing Association (DRYA). Competing clubs must have their entry submitted to the Race Committee, on the Registration Form provided, prior to 6 p.m. on the Wednesday immediately preceding the race. Any entries submitted later will be accepted at the discretion of the race committee.

A "Team" from each club shall consist of four boats, each of which will race in one of the four classes in this race.

- PHRF A (Multi-sail) - up to 108
- PHRF B (Multi-sail) - 90 to 144
- PHRF C (Multi-sail) - 126 to 177
- PHRF D (Multi-sail) - 159 and up

Again this year: There will be no dedicated JAM class, but rather, the multi-sail rule will apply. Please refer to race instructions for details.

The finishing positions of each club's boats are totaled to determine the club's score. Please see the Race Instructions for the official racing rules. The race will be sailed on the LSSC course and will be approx. 12 nautical miles in length.

The class splits and pennants will be available on Friday evening, October 1st, 2010 after 7 p.m. at the Race Headquarters. Also, please plan to join us there for the Awards Party after the race. Race Headquarters for all activities this year is Dockside Jack's Waterfront Restaurant located off Jefferson Avenue between Nine and Ten Mile Roads in St. Clair Shores.

We trust this will be an enjoyable event for your club and crews and hope you will join us for all the planned activities. LSSC is pleased to have the opportunity to be your host.
