



# Procedure for using Edison Boat Club Owned Boats

All qualified sailing and power boat Skippers,

There is now a marker board system for checking out all club owned boats located in the main entrance hall next to the sign in book. Please update this new board when using any of the club owned boats - and be sure to erase your checkout when you get back. The checkout cards located in the sail locker are now only to be used for reporting damage to the boats.

This new checkout board procedure will allow you to determine the status (returned or overdue) of any club owned boat upon arrival at the club. When in doubt, please use the following procedure:

1. If a boat is overdue please look to see if the boat is in the marina and the checkout did not get erased.
2. Please call the phone number listed with the skippers name to determine their whereabouts.
3. Look on the water in front of the club to see if they are maneuvering and just late returning.
4. If you have reason to believe a boat is in trouble, and you can't find help within the marina, call the Coast Guard. REMEMBER while we don't want false alarms going to the Coast Guard, we also don't want to leave someone in trouble, if we can send help in a timely manner.

Thanks to all for bearing with us through this change. The goal, as always, is the enjoyment and safe return and of all EBC members.
