Official Chili Cook-off Rules and Guidelines

1. Chili must be cooked on site.
2. Chili must be cooked from scratch- "Scratch" defined as starting with raw meat. No pre-marinating is allowed. Commercial chili powder is permissible, but complete commercial chili mixes ("just add meat" mixes that contain pre-measured spice) are NOT permitted!
3. No filler in chili—Bean, macaroni, rice, hominy, or other similar ingredients are not permitted.
4. No wild game may be used.

Judging

Three 1/2 cup servings will be collected for each entry at 2:45pm. Judge cups will be provided to contestants at the cooks meeting. These cups will be associated with your team—do not lose them!

Judging Criteria to include: 1. Color 2. Consistency 3. Appearance 4. Presentation 5. Taste 6. After-Taste

5. Planned Awards —1st, 2nd & 3rd, People's Choice and Best Presentation

What you should or might want to remember to bring:

- Portable cooking stove and fuel—"Coleman-type" propane (electrical outlet available if required)
- Cooking pot, cutting board, knife, paper towels, spoons, can opener, etc.
- Meat (hand cut or chili grind), spices, and other ingredients to make approximately 1 ½ - 2 gallons of chili
- If competing for best presentation---bring props, costume(s), team name sign, decoration, and other gear!
